



Welcome to the YMCA Jr. Huskers Flag Football Tournament. The YMCA Jr. Huskers Tournament is designed to give teams an opportunity to play two extra games at the end of the fall season.

All YMCA Jr. Huskers flag football rules will apply. Games will consist of two 22-minute halves with a 3-minute half time. On the day of the tournament, if any questions/concerns arise, direct them to a YMCA Site Supervisor. Please remember this is not in a competitive tournament, so please show sportsmanship and respect all who attends. You may not protest the game, if you have an issue with an official's call please locate the Site Supervisor in attendance but do not interrupt the game. Please remember the officials are watching the entire game, not just your team so you may see something they may not. This does not mean you are wrong, so please work with them not against them.

Overtime will be in effect for the tournament. Overtime is defined if both teams are tied at the end of the  $2^{nd}$  Half. Overtime rules will be posted below and on the Rules Sheet.

## Overtime Rules

If games end in a tie below is the overtime rule:

- Coin-flip to determine who receives first possession.
- The overtime periods will alternate who plays offense first and who plays defense first. Each team will get a try per overtime period.
- Each overtime period, both teams will have the opportunity to try for 1 or 2 points, depending on what the team would rather do. (1pt from 3-yard line and 2 pts from 10-yard line)
- The team in the lead at the end of an overtime period will be the winner of the game

Awards will be given to 1st and 2nd place for each bracket or pool. Medals in 4 team brackets will be awarded to the top 2 teams (2-0 equals first place and 1-1 while winning the first game will lead to a 2nd place in the 4 team brackets). Placement for the pools (3 or 5 teams) will be determined as follows:

Any team that goes unbeaten in their pool will receive 1st place medals.

1st Place Criteria: best record,

if still tied . . . head to head if still tied . . . point differential

2<sup>nd</sup> Place Criteria: second best record,

if still tied . . . least amount of points allowed

if still tied . . . point differential

Please remember Coaches/players/fans to first have **FUN**, show **GOOD SPORTMANSHIP**, and to be **POSITIVE**
